Commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1 1.—(1) Marriage Contract entered between persons of same Gender is

Prohibition of marriage by persons of same gender.

- hereby prohibited in Nigeria.
 (2) Marriages Contract entered between persons of same gender are invalid
- 4 and shall not be recognized as entitled to the benefits of a valid marriage.
- 5 (3) Marriage Contract entered between persons of same gender by virtue
 - a certificate issued by a foreign country shall be void in Nigeria, and any
- a certificate issued by a foreign country shall be voted in Tagetta,

 benefits accruing there from by virtue of the certificate shall not be enforced by

- 9 2.—(1) Marriage entered between persons of same Gender shall not be
- 10 solemnized in any place of worship either Church or Mosque in Nigeria.
 - (2) No marriage certificate issued to parties of same sex marriage in Nigeria.
- Only marriage contracted between a man and a woman either under
- 14 Islamic Law, Customary Law and Marriage Act is recognized as valid in Nigeria.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to prohibit marriage between persons of same gender, and witnessing same, and provided appropriate solemnization of the marriage penalties thereof.
